Tuition for Knox Christian School is based on the incremental child rate. In order for Knox to meet its financial obligations, the following fees apply. Transportation within our boundaries is included in the following amounts with a Transportation Commitment Surcharge applied to secure a family's spot on the transportation list. If you will not be using the bus, please do not register for a spot.

Canada Revenue Agency allows a portion of the tuition fee paid to a Christian school to be eligible for a donation receipt, which can be claimed on your personal income tax return and may create a tax credit or refund for the year. To determine the donation amount, the cost per pupil (as determined by the Edvance Christian Schools Association) is deducted from the tuition fees paid in the year. For example, if the cost per pupil was \$4,000, a family with two full-time students (\$15,434-\$4,000-\$4,000) would receive a donation receipt of \$7,434. Please note that the cost per pupil changes every year, and that every family's tax situation is different. These numbers are examples only.

BRIDGE BURSARY OPTION

BRIDGE BURSARY: \$2,200

Families with children attending both Durham Christian High School and Knox Christian School are eligible to receive a bursary towards the Knox tuition payment.

ANNUAL ENROLMENT ADMINISTRATION FEE

All families enrolling their children at Knox must pay an annual enrolment fee of \$250. This fee is due at Registration time and again for each new school year, **it is not a part of tuition.**

TUITION ARREARS POLICY

POLICY

The following procedures will be followed for families who fall behind in their tuition payments as they have outlined in the Knox Tuition Form payment options.

1. **After 30 Days:** A tuition statement letter will be sent detailing the amount in arrears, requesting payment for amount owing.
2. **After 45 Days:** A phone call from a member of the Finance Committee reminding them of their arrears and requesting payment.
3. **After 60 Days:** A visit by two members of the Finance Committee will be arranged. A personal evaluation of the financial situation will be made and a recommendation made to the Knox Board. This may include a revised plan; however, all outstanding tuition payments must be paid by July 31 of the current school year. Should tuition still be in arrears, the parents will not be permitted to register their children the following year, and report cards will not be released. This will be waived when the tuition arrears are paid in full.
4. **After 90 Days:** The Knox Board will be fully informed of the arrears account, and reserves the right to notify the family by registered mail that attendance will be denied for Knox Christian School until all financial accounts have been cleared. Parents lose their privilege of attending or voting at Society Meetings.

All N.S.F. cheques will result in a \$30 charge/incident.

The board may exercise the right to take legal action as part of its fiduciary responsibilities

Summary:

With the privilege of providing Christian education to our school children also comes the responsibility of meeting our obligations towards the financial wellbeing of the school. Each family is expected to cooperate with the school administrative body through prompt and timely payment of tuition to ensure the continuing availability of quality Christian education at Knox Christian School.

FAMILY WITHDRAWAL POLICY

FAMILY WITHDRAWAL PLEASE READ AND SIGN BELOW

When a family voluntarily withdraws from the school for any reason, it must give at least **one full calendar month's written notice** to the school. Written notice must be provided to the Financial Administrator. Tuition for the entire current month, plus the next month will be charged to the family's account.
